



25 - 50 - 100 NIGHT CAMPER AWARD

- (1) Make a layout of a typical patrol campsite, including location of cooking facilities, dining fly, latrine, and at least three two-man tents. Explain how and why weather, season, and water supply are taken into consideration when choosing a site. Also, explain what precautions are necessary with regard to safe water, sanitary facilities, and emergencies.
- (2) Prepare a checklist of clothing you would need for an overnight camp in (a) summer, and (b) winter. Explain the types of footwear for various weather conditions and explain proper care of the feet.
- (3) Make a checklist of necessary personal equipment and patrol equipment for an overnight camp.
- (4) Assemble and pack your personal gear and your share of patrol equipment and food for proper carrying and protection against bad weather. Point out how your pack conforms with good practice with regard to items needed first, comfort, minimum weight, balance size, and neatness.
- (5) If Scout has earned Camping merit badge, he need not requalify for requirements (1) through (4).
- (6) Give evidence of experience at Scout camping as follows: (a) camp out for a total of at least 25 days and nights, sleeping each night under the sky or under a tent you have pitched; a minimum of 6 days and nights of long term camp (summer camp or trek) must be included within the total 25 days and nights.
- (7) Be a Second Class Scout.
